#### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:**

Each year, the California Department of Transportation and RTA must recertify to the Federal Transit Administration that all applicable Federal requirements are adhered to when administering Federal grants. To this end, the California Department of Transportation and RTA obtain certification from sub-recipient agencies that they too will comply with applicable Federal requirements.

RTA needs to execute and submit the 2016 Certifications and Assurances document to the appropriate agencies to remain an eligible grantee and sub-recipient of FTA funds. RTA fulfills this requirement annually and ensures that these Federal requirements are followed. The attached 2016 Certifications and Assurances document was published by FTA on February 26, 2016.
