Morro Bay Transit & Atascadero DAR Consolidation into the RTA

- Both agencies are successfully consolidated into the RTA
- We continue working with staff from both cities

 Passengers are happy with transition and quality of services



Operations & Maintenance

- Eight open bids: Five full-time, three part-time
 - Covered by Extra Board and Casual drivers or Supervisors

 Also recruiting for one Mechanic and three Operations Supervisors

Marketing & Communications

 Development and distribution of communications materials for the August 10th service changes

Recruitment ads for Bus Operators running on social media and radio stations

 Created ~40 custom trip plans to help people learn how to ride the bus, one person at a time

Maintenance & Facilities

- Design/build projects update: Phase 2 of EVSE & the Photovoltaic System
 - Both projects awarded to Electricraft, Inc.
 - Expect to begin construction late October
 - With equipment in the yard, we are cancelling annual Bus Roadeo

Finance and Administration

In negotiations with Teamsters Local 986

- Current agreement expires Dec 31, 2025
- This CBA covers Bus Operators, the Parts Clerk,
 Mechanics and Utility workers



Finance & Administration

- Submitted grant applications for four BEBs in January 2025
 - Still waiting for approval from the FTA
- Five BEBs scheduled for deliver within 30 days
 - Price increase due to tariffs of \$65K/bus



Finance & Administration

- Installed two new passenger shelters at Cuesta College main campus, including new LED next-bus sign
- Cuesta paid the 20% local share of FTA funded capital equipment, and 100% of installation costs

Hope to begin use of shelter mid-October



FY24-25 Operating Results

- RTA intercity fixed-route ridership increased 3.3% over last year
 - Still 34% below pre-pandemic totals

Runabout up 1.9%

Paso Robles local fixed-routes up 8.0% (up 25.2% since pandemic)

South County fixed-routes: down 2.7%

FY24-25 Financial Results

- Year-end non-capital expenses:
 - 96.5% (corrected) of the annual Administrative budget
 - 89.1% of the of the annual Operations budget

- Subsidy per one-way passenger-trip:
 - Intercity fixed-route \$15.02
 - Runabout \$140.90 *(\$93.11 factoring in FR rides)*
 - Paso Robles local FR \$5.87
 - South County FR \$11.75

Background on SB125 Program

- \$4B distributed statewide through TIRCP and ZETCP to fund zero-emission transit & rail projects
- RTA submitted 13 projects to SLOCOG in November 2023

 RTA Board authorized cooperative agreement for 12 projects at its November 2024 meeting.



Update on In-Process Projects

- RTA-1 Partial funding for 5 BEBs
 - Vehicles will be delivered in September



- RTA-2 Phase 2 EVSE
 - Design/Build (D/B) contract awarded to Electricraft, Inc.
 - Mobilize in October

- RTA-3 Master planning and D/B charging projects
 - Study contracted to Stantec Engineering
 - First working paper due mid-September

Background on EnergliZE Program

 CEC has funding authority of \$544M to incentivize medium- and heavy-duty vehicles and related charging equipment

 Over \$240M available now, which can help fully fund RTA's projects already using SB125 and (potential) \$1.7M CEC/ARFVTP



Potential EnergIIZE Projects

- RTA-9 Phase 3 in Bus Maintenance Facility
- RTA-10 Opportunity Charging at Morro Bay Transit
 Center
- RTA-12 Opportunity Charging at SLO Government
 Center passenger facility

Background and Need

RTA & County OES already partner on Nuclear Power
 Plant Emergency Response Plan

 However, no formal agreement for other emergencies/disaster assistance

 Draft MOU identifies roles and responsibilities, as well as methods to recover costs
